## OVERVIEW

An icon on the downtown waterfront, the facility is comprised of two uniquely designed buildings: Vancouver Convention Centre East and West.

Centrally located, surrounded by ocean and mountains, and perfectly balanced by a vibrant, urban downtown inhabited by world-class restaurants, hotels and shopping.

The facility covers 1.2 million ft<sup>2</sup> (111,500 m<sup>2</sup>) or four city blocks, with the West building built 60% on land and 40% over water.

First ever repeat winner of the International Association of Congress Centres (AIPC) award for 'World's Best Convention Centre' (2002, 2008).

## BUILDING FEATURES

- Canada's largest convention centre waterfront ballroom at 53,000 ft<sup>2</sup> (4,920 m<sup>2</sup>) with five-story high ceilings and breathtaking mountain vistas.
- Outdoor terrace and plaza areas offering spectacular harbour and mountain views.
- Two acre (0.8 hectare) public plaza with waterfront walkway.
- 295 ft (90 m) long, glass-enclosed connector provides a covered walkway between East and West buildings.
- Close to 150,000 ft<sup>2</sup> (14,000 m<sup>2</sup>) of magnificent pre-function space with natural light and breathtaking views.

## ENVIRONMENTAL DESIGN

A number of sustainable practices and environmentally-conscious design features make the Vancouver Convention Centre one of the greenest convention centres in the world.

- The West building has received LEED® (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design) Platinum certification, making the Vancouver Convention Centre the first convention centre in the world to receive the highest LEED® rating.
- Commitment to advanced energy management with experience hosting 'zero waste' events.
- Extensive facility-wide recycling program recovers nearly half the total volume of waste generated.
- The West building features a unique marine habitat, a sophisticated drainage and water recovery system, and a seawater heating and cooling system.
- A six acre 'living roof', the largest green roof in Canada and the largest non-industrial living roof in North America, on the West building features more than 400,000 indigenous plants and four beehives.
